1. CHRISTMAS PERFORMANCES

In the context of rising COVID cases in the community, it is with cautious enthusiasm that we look forward to our Christmas performances and ask for your assistance to ensure that the safety mitigations we have in place are implemented as smoothly as possible.

All seats have now been allocated and you should have your seat reservation card. Please bring this to the Carol Service to ensure you are seated promptly.

There will be a 1 metre space between each pair of guests. No guests should arrive on the evening without prior booking.

Please go directly to your allocated seat and avoid mingling.

Please note that guidance on the back of tickets re masks has now been updated by The Presbyterian Church Ireland: - Masks must be worn at all times.

At the <u>end of the service</u>, to ensure a safe, quick and smooth exit, we would ask that guests remain seated until advised to leave. Guests will leave in order according to their children's classes to facilitate the collection of pupils. Children will be lined up in the foyer, class by class and parents/guardians will leave in this order collecting their child(ren) as they walk through. We would ask parents/ guardians to leave directly and not mingle.

I apologise for such un-festive, detailed, prescriptive directions! However I believe that strict adherence is the only way in which we would feel that we can proceed with these Carol Services in a safe, responsible manner, and I thank you in advance for your cooperation.
